



OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ASCOTT, MILTON AND SHIPTON-UNDER-WYCHWOOD PARISHES) (SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order, due to road safety concerns by Shipton Under Wychwood Parish Council, is to extend the **30mph speed limit** on the A361 Station Road a point 146 metres northeast of the rail bridge replacing the existing 40mph speed limit.

For administrative reasons only, the Shipton order will be combined with the (Milton-Under-Wychwood Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2002 and Ascott restricted roads and will be revoked/replaced.
