<p>Risk of COVID through interaction with colleagues/members of the public</p>	<p>If a lockdown is introduced by Government all speedwatch activity must cease.</p> <p>Volunteers only attend if they feel fit and well.</p> <p>Volunteers are not to share equipment between different households unless essential. Shared equipment must be wiped before sharing with anti-virus wipes.</p> <p>Volunteers must keep at 2m distance from their colleague and members of the public.</p> <p>If not possible, PPE must be worn. PPE can be made available from TVP (request in advance) i.e. masks, hand sanitiser, gloves.</p>	<p>This must be observed.</p>	

RESTRICTED (WHEN COMPLETED)

	Any concerns relating to potential spread of COVID must be reported to TVP.		
Are there any sight line difficulties? Does the position of the CSW cause any difficulties?	CSW device is not to be located on or near a bend or busy junction. HiVis jackets must be provided. Volunteers must wear jackets at all times.	There must be NO sightline difficulties	
Location	The scheme is not suitable for use in the sight or vicinity of an existing speed camera or other speed monitoring device. If using a hand held device Operator must stand at a safe distance away from the roadside (minimum 2m) Operator must not stand in the road <u>at any time.</u>	This must be observed	
Parked cars and other private property	Ensure the device and signs are not placed near parked cars or private property.	Assess on day	
Is the presence of road works causing difficulties?	If so do not operate CSW at this location.	If roadworks NO speedwatch will take place	
Injuries when erecting or packing away the CSW equipment	CSW is attached to tripod securely, unless using a handheld device. Volunteers are advised to keep the CSW at the required level, according to manufacturer's guidelines. They are not to leave the CSW unattended, and must ensure footways are not blocked.	This must be observed	
Injuries to volunteers	HiVis jackets are provided, these must be worn during the operation, setting up and packing away the equipment.	This must be observed	

RESTRICTED (WHEN COMPLETED)

	Volunteers must not stand in the road at any time.		
Weather (bad weather conditions)	CSW should not be operational during bad weather periods i.e. fog, mist, snow, sleet, ice, heavy rain and storms.	Will NOT operate in poor weather conditions	
Monitoring	Monitoring to be undertaken by a minimum of 3 volunteers if using a handheld device and 2 if using a free standing device. It is recommended that at least one person is equipped with a working mobile phone.	This must be observed
